

A Light Bulb Moment!!

"In early April 2019 I was watching the news on TV which was reporting the visit of Greta Thunberg to Parliament and her campaign to inspire children throughout the world to "strike" from school on Fridays. The picture showed all the competing flags and banners getting higher and higher and above them the Union Flag on the Victoria Tower.
